This Cooperation Protocol is celebrated between a FABULA C-PLUS Project partner and the interested organisation.

### I – Purpose

The purpose of this Cooperation Protocol is to promote the cooperation between the signing organisations (parties) thus increasing the aim and results of the FABULA C-PLUS PROJECY project so as to continue to propose themself as an open transnational network, responding to the brand "FABULA C-Plus", to feed in progress the results and medium-long term impacts induced by the systematic adoption of the Open Educational Resources, implemented in the form of virtual tours, and of the CIRCLE Game for children to discover and learn the concepts-basics of the circular economy, thus fostering a process of knowledge and approach to the topic and accompanying them on a path that supported them in the development of creativity, inventiveness and entrepreneurship.

### II – Statement of mutual interest

The parties agree that it is to their mutual interest to work cooperatively to promote the exchange of good practices, cross-training and peer counselling between Schools, VET providers, SMES, Public Bodies and HEIs and exploit the results developed during the lifetime of the FABULA C-PLUS project, while also involving other other stakeholders such as: schools, academic bodies, training agencies, institutions, companies, trade unions, business organizations.

### III – Responsibilities of all parties under this Cooperation Protocol

1. Promote the implementation of the FABULA C-PLUS framework and the access the learning environment FEDRO fostering digital integration in learning through access to a plurality of OERs and experimenting with innovative forms of interactive, gamified and laboratory-based teaching that are flexible and adaptable to the needs of younger generations and future European societies



2. Develop in students an early circular mind-set inherent in the sense of initiative and entrepreneurship capable of generating new creative ideas in the area of reusing and recycling resources, with the adoption of an interactive, gamified and laboratory model of teaching, capable of evolving methods, tools, solutions and learning situations.
3. Enlarge the Trainers Network of teachers allowing them to adopt the "CiCLE" model for conducting Circular Creativity Labs for Entrepreneurship to empower learners to apply the knowledge learned and translate it into "Re-CiCLE" ideas.,
4. Update, disseminate and exploit the outputs of the FABULA C-PLUS Project, beyond the funding period;
5. Attract other members, thus contributing to the sustainability of the network;
6. Support the signing parties, providing training and sharing information, to help with the implementation of EU policies relevant for Education and Training and the competence building of the staff;
7. Support the signing parties, providing training and sharing information, to help with the application of proposals for EU funding;
8. Inform the parties when updates on the implementation of EU policies relevant for Education and Training and on the application of proposals for EU funding are made;
9. Appoint a contact person for the purposes of this Cooperation Protocol who will be responsible for ensuring all appropriate communication between the signing parties;
10. Update the contact person in case of staff change.

#### IV – Consultation and Exchange of Information

The parties shall keep each other informed and consult on matters of common interest, which are likely to lead to mutual collaboration.

#### V – Amendments

Modifications within the scope of this Cooperation Protocol shall be made by mutual agreement of all parties, by the issuance of a written modification, dated and signed by all parties, prior to any changes being performed.

#### VI – Commencement and termination dates

1. This Cooperation Protocol is valid for a period of no less than 5 years counting from the date of its signature, and it is renewable for equal periods.



2. Any party, in writing, may terminate their participation in this Cooperation Protocol, in whole, or in part, at any time before the date of expiration.
3. No party shall be liable for failure to perform its obligations where such failure is due to pandemic, fire, flood, strike, legal restrictions, riots, insurrection or any other cause beyond the reasonable control (force majeure) of the party in question and without fault on its part. The defaulting party shall, however, take all immediate and diligent measures to mitigate the effects of the force majeure event.
4. This Cooperation Protocol takes effect as of the date of the last signature.
